This sober/spiritual way of life is meant to give us quiet inner peace and the joy that only being in the Presence of God can give. A spiritual basis of living life gives us the Higher Power that we can stay sober by-the Divine Spirit of God heals the mind and energizes the soul. We will feel calm and relaxed once we have placed the process of the 12 Steps into our minds, lives, hearts, souls and daily actions. These Steps and Traditions resolve our spiritual malady which is our separation from God. These spiritual principles restore us to our right sane minds which will go a long way in solving all sorts of problems and troubles and protect us from many dangers.

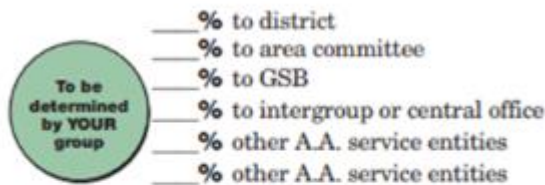

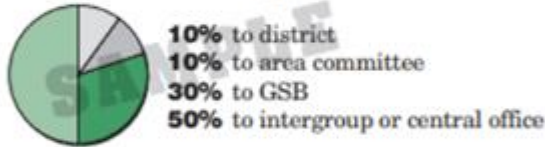
## CBIA Appreciates Ongoing Support

### Samples of Group Contributions to A.A. Service Entities

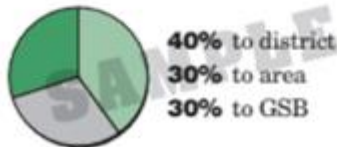
