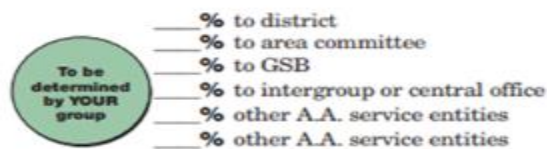

If possible, be generous, especially this year! Our community is so fortunate to have these services.

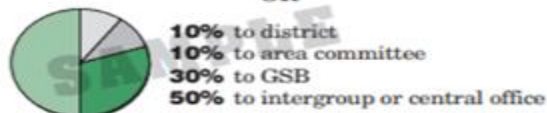

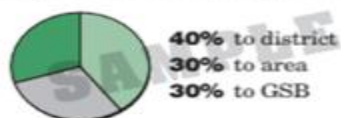

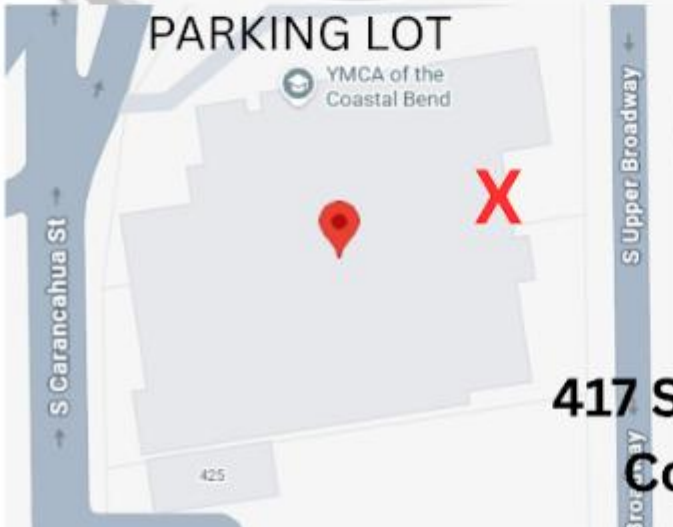

Helpline Help Needed!

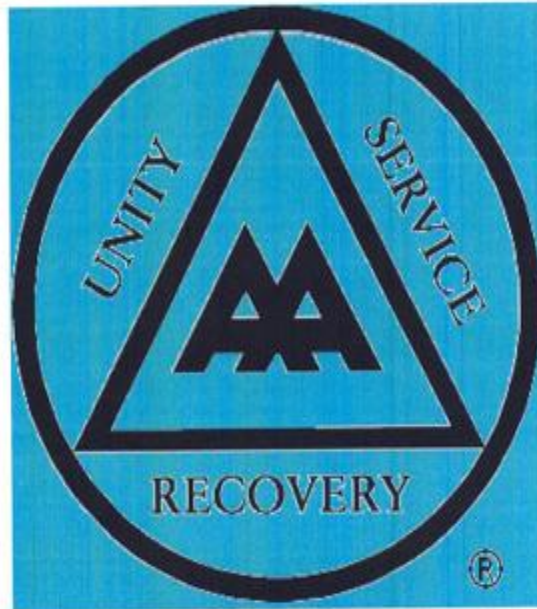
12 Step List

A minimum of two years' sobriety is required to be on the 12 Step List.
